We have enjoyed listening to Rev. Winston Smith introduce us to the work of the Holy Spirit in Jamaica. Rev. Smith is the President of the National Baptist Church Incorporated in Jamaica. A group of our Students are seeking God’s will for a Mission “Diyoto” (working together) in Manchester, Jamaica.

Two mission teams are heading to the Democratic Republic of Congo to work in rural clinics and train Congolese missionaries.
